How are students doing? These statistics are based on the calendar years 2010-2011 of students scheduled to graduate within that time frame. The placement rate is based on students obtaining employment in the trucking industry within 6 months of graduation.

According to our latest information:

93% (250 out of 269) students in the program scheduled to graduate between **1-1-10** and **12-31-11** completed the course and did graduate.

100% (250 out of 250) students in the program taking the Class A driver test administered by the State of California Department of Motor Vehicles between **1-1-10** and **12-31-11** passed that test and became licensed.

96% (240 out of 250) students that completed the course between **1-1-10** and **12-31-11** have obtained employment within the trucking industry.

The state requirements for obtaining a Commercial Driver's license are:

- Must be at least age 18
- Must submit to and pass the Department of Transportation physical exam
- Submit a signed Application for a Driver's license
- Submit a Birth Certificate, if applicable
- Submit a document verifying your social security number
- Have no outstanding tickets from any state
- Have no more than 4 points in 1 year, 6 points within 2 years, or 8 points within 3 years on the driving record
- Must surrender all out-of-state driver's license
- Pay applicable fee for license and endorsements
- Pass the knowledge written test, pre-trip inspection test, skills test and driving test
